Three teams are being entered in to Durham & Cleveland Leagues.

In order to be involved, adult members are required to pay £15 to England Squash (which gives to £10 million of public liability and personal accident cover plus additional benefits).

This season the 1st and 3rd team will play on a Wednesday evening and the 2nds will play on Monday.

Please note: that the nominations are currently provisional.

Best of luck to everyone!!!

- Teams consist of 5 players and are ordered on ability (so respective numbers 1's play each other, 2's play each other, down to the number 5 playing the opposite number 5).
- Home teams players are expected to mark at least 1 match (senior/veteran players are on hand to assist juniors)
- Team etiquette is for players to socialise after the match where:
- Home teams provide food for the opponents. (The senior /captain should arrange; this is normally pizzas, pies or similar
 for matches at Nunthorpe, but at times we have seen home cooking, curries and other flamboyant recipes being delivered).
- The cost of the of food is shared out between home team members. The club subsidises the majority of the food cost and there is an additional subsidy for juniors (so this cost should be minimal, if any cost at all).
- There is no cost for away team matches.
- Matches are scheduled to start at 7:15pm. Teams generally depart around 10ish, depending on match time and time spent socialising.
- There is a commitment to the team and regular attendance required, as we do need 5 players to play each match.


