of Conduct Policy

Purpose: The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to establish the standards of behaviour and professionalism expected from referees officiating at Nunthorpe Squash Club events. Referees play a crucial role in ensuring fair play, upholding the rules of the game, and maintaining a positive and respectful atmosphere.

Code of Conduct:

1. Impartiality:

- Referees must officiate matches with impartiality, without bias or favouritism towards any player or team.
- Avoid any conflicts of interest that may compromise impartial judgment.

2. Knowledge and Understanding:

- o Stay updated on the latest rules and regulations of squash.
- Attend training sessions and workshops to enhance knowledge and understanding of the game.

3. Professionalism:

- o Always conduct oneself in a professional manner.
- Treat players, coaches, and fellow officials with respect and courtesy.

4. Consistency:

- o Handle disputes and conflicts in a calm and controlled manner.
- o Report any incidents or concerns to the appropriate authorities.

players, coaches	, or other officials should not be shared publicly.

disciplinary action, including but not limited to verbal warnings, suspension from	
refereeing duties, or removal from officiating at Nunthorpe Squash Club events.
