- Post-Match Duties: All team members are encouraged to stay after the match to help entertain our visitors and to assist in cleaning and tidying up once the visitors have left.

We understand that there may be occasions where immediate departure after a match is necessary due to work or personal commitments.

If such a situation arises, please inform the Team Captain in advance.

If any member feels unable to adhere to these provisions, we kindly ask that they reconsider their position within the team.
