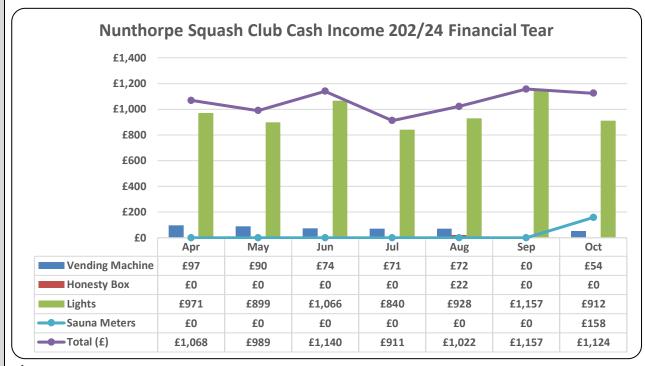


Nunthorpe Squash Club
