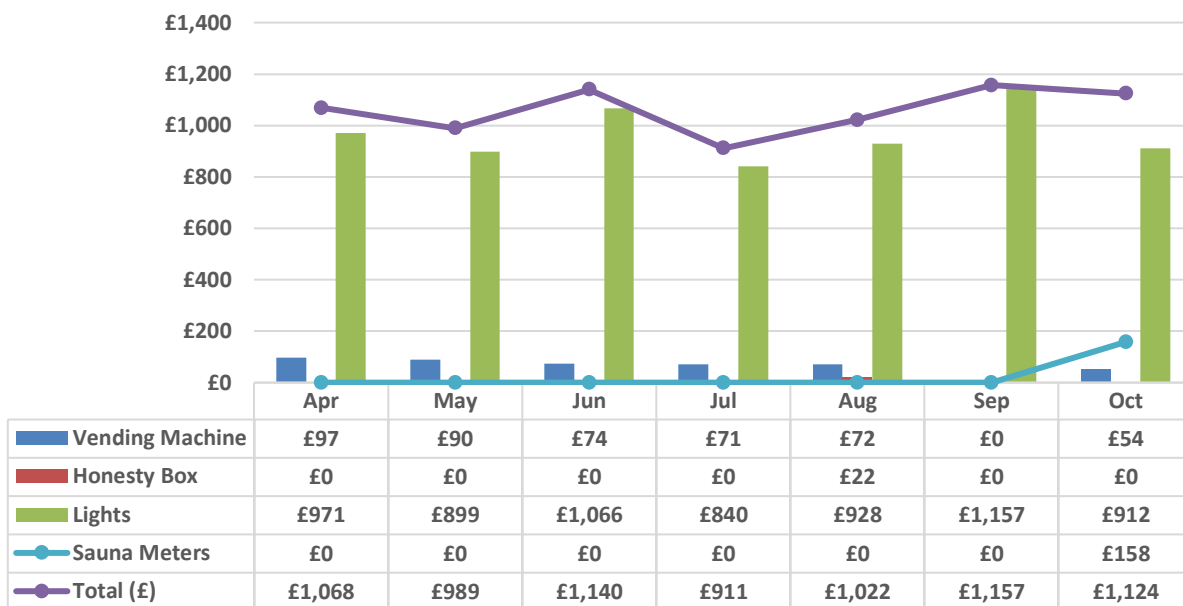


- Lower than expected light, sauna, and vending revenue but it was noted that court maintenance had affected revenue stream and members visits due to courts be out of action.
