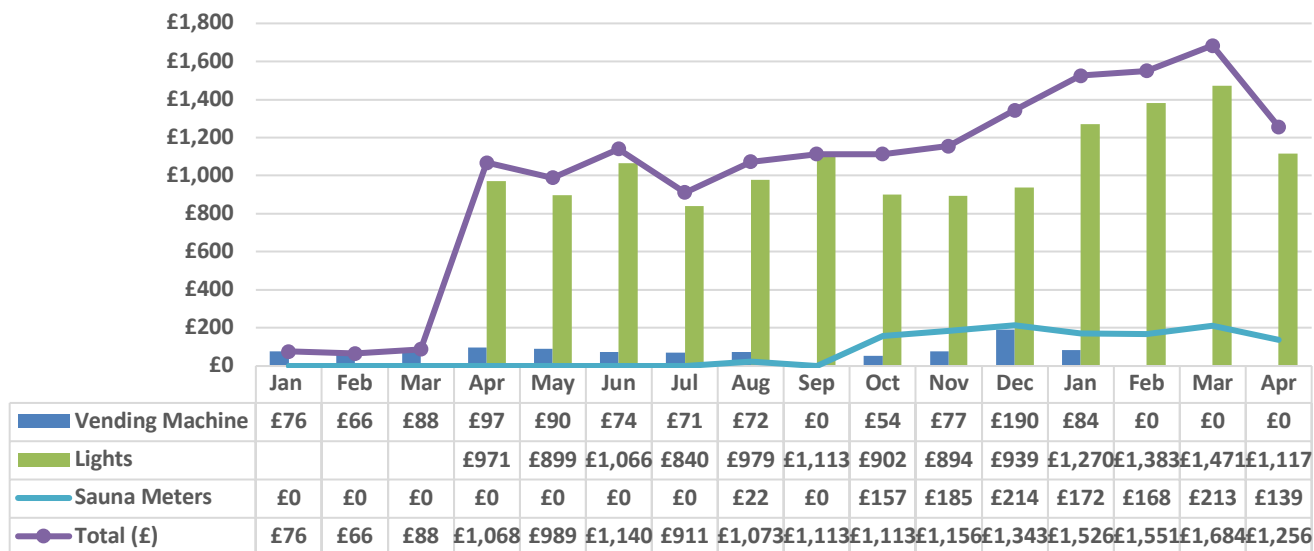


1. General discussion around invoices received - Treasurers report indicated expenditure through April with commentary on all lines, general discussion on legal fees and await update.
